

Community Mediation 40-hour course

Learn the art of helping others resolve their own conflicts.

Our Family's basic-skills mediation course prepares participants to mediate a variety of workplace, family, and personal conflicts.

The course is required for anyone interested in working as a volunteer with the Community Mediation Program, although it is no guarantee of a future position. Call for volunteer opportunities.

Classes are limited to 24 participants, and registration is on a first-come basis. To complete the course, you must attend all classes. A \$50 nonrefundable deposit is due at registration.

Class fee includes: training manual, 35 hours of interactive classroom instruction, reading material (5 hrs), and a certificate of completion.

Course content includes: conflict resolution theory, communication skills, mediation process and techniques, impasse strategies, effective agreements, ethics, and working with a co-mediator.
