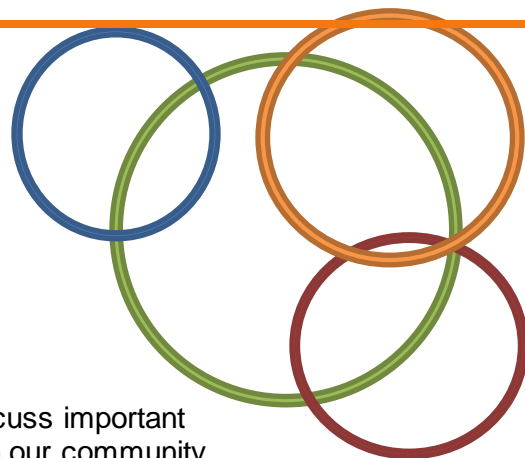


Elder Circles
