

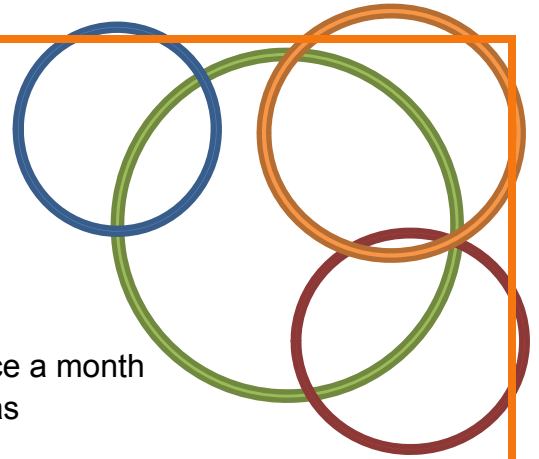
Elder Circles
