

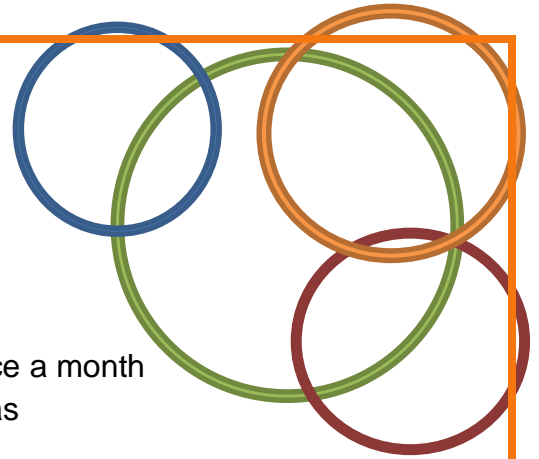
# Elder Circles
